

## **BRISTOL NORTH JUNIOR OPEN MEET**

### **PROMOTER'S CONDITIONS**

1. The competition will be held under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules.
2. All entrants must be members of an affiliated club and be amateurs as defined by ASA Law.
3. Age as at 31 August in the year of competition. Swimmers may swim up in team events only.
4. The closing date for entries is 30 June prior to the event.
5. The correct entry fees and a SAE (12¾"x 9") must accompany entry forms. Cheques to be made payable to "Bristol North Swimming Club".
6. All entry times must be converted to 25 metre pool length.
7. The promoters reserve the right to reject entries, in which case entry fees will be refunded.
8. All entry cards must be posted in the box at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each session.
9. Warm-up begins 30 minutes before the start of each session (where time permits).
10. Competitors to report to the Stewards three heats prior to their own. Competitors in the first three heats of each session to report at the end of warm-up.
11. Only Competitors, Officials and holders of a Coach Pass (maximum 3 per club) will be allowed on poolside or on the swimmers' balcony.
12. Nine-year-olds are only permitted to swim one butterfly event. Any swimmer who submits entries for both events will be accepted for the 50m event only.
13. All 9-year-old swimmers starting at the shallow end shall start in the water. In 10 year old 4 x 25m events it is the responsibility of the Team Manager to ensure that swimmers starting at the shallow end are competent to perform a shallow racing div
14. Swimmers may only swim for one club during the meet.
15. All finalists will receive an award unless disqualified.
16. Points will be awarded on final placings towards overall Top Club and best Boy and Girl trophies.
17. Events will be swum on the heats and final basis unless otherwise indicated (the promoters reserve the right to amend this if necessary). Heats will be seeded according to entry time with the fastest eight swimmers from the heats going forward to the
18. The promoters reserve the right to decide the number of heats in each event in accordance with the entries.
19. All clothing/valuables etc. left in the changing rooms or other areas will be entirely at the owner's risk.
20. A computer will be used to help with entries and results; by accepting these conditions a swimmer is agreeing to data (e.g. name, age, club and times) being held in the computer and released during and after the event.
21. The promoters reserve the right to alter these conditions as may be deemed necessary.
