ENTRIES

Submitting an entry to this meet means you have read and will abide by all conditions in this meet pack.

All entries must be submitted via online entry (NEW) or club entries must be sent together with one cheque to cover all payment

- **NEW:** Online entry (**open from 24/10/11**) can be submitted by following these steps (Nothing needs to be sent by post except the medical questionnaire for Multi Classification Entries and a Team Manager results file will still be sent after the event):
 1. Click [HERE](#) after 24/10/11 for online entry
 2. Enter your registration number and click fetch times
 3. Delete any events with times that you do not wish to enter
 4. Click add to the entry list
 5. Submit entries
 6. Pay following the onscreen instructions

For Team Manager Entries: Only one file per club is permitted. No entries will be processed until the correct payment is received by the closing date.

To ensure all course conversion factors are the same please follow these instructions:

Open the database. Use Set-up on the header bar/Course conversion/Under the SC meters to/from LC Meters turn factors place 0.02 in the box entitled Straight factor ___ Applied to all strokes.

All times within the database will automatically be converted as Long Course times. The Custom time box should NOT be used (All times will be checked against the rankings database and any time not able to be proved will result in removal from the event).

The following reports are required to accompany the entry file for TM entries: Hy-Tek Meet entry sorted by name and Hy-Tek meet entry fee (located under the reports header/performance) along with the Meet Summary Sheet (in this entry pack).

The meet reports & summary must be completed in full and returned together with the relevant entry fee to the Swim Wales Office, Wales National Pool, Sketty Lane, Swansea, SA2 8QG by the closing date.

It is strongly recommended that you return your entries by RECORDED DELIVERY to ensure receipt. Cheques should be made payable to Swim Wales "and crossed"

Entries will be rejected for the following reasons:

- They are received without the relevant fee
- Incorrectly completed
- Improved entries
- Received with the relevant fees after the closing date

Entries may be rejected for the following reason:

- Application to officiate/volunteer form (located on http://www.welshasa.co.uk/c_se_swimming.asp is not forwarded to the Swim Wales Office by the closing date (for clubs entering more than 4 swimmers).
- Multi Classification Entries received without the medical questionnaire

NB: Swim Wales may request validation of any stated entry time and reserve the right to return entries if the meet is oversubscribed.

- Multi Classification Events are open age group.

HEATS

- Qualifying times are in place for this meet. Please see enclosed time standards for further information
- Qualifying times must be achieved in the year prior to the closing date in a licensed meet or an event approved by the organisers.
- Heats will be seeded slow to fast with the fastest three heats of non Heat declared winner events being cyclically seeded.
- Multi Classification events will be seeded slow to fast regardless of classification.

FINALS

- A 2 Call Room procedure will be in operation. Please see rule 06.06 in general conditions
- A & B Finals will be swum for 50, 100 and 200m events in the Senior & Youth Section
- A Finals will be swum for the 400m events in the Senior & Youth Section
- All finals in the Senior & Youth Section will be Open Age Finals
- B finals shall be swum before A Finals
- B finals will only take place if at least 24 competitors qualify for the final in the heat of the event.
- 800m & 1500m Events are Heat Declared Winner competitions and the fastest heat will be swum in the finals session.
- Finals will be swum for both Age Bands in the Age Group Section.
- Finals will be swum for Multi Classification events

PRIZES

- Medals will be awarded for 1st – 3rd places in Senior & Youth Sections (Results will be taken firstly from the A Final, if there are less than 3 swimmers in the age group, then the results will be followed by the B Final and then the Heats)
- Medals will be awarded to both age group categories.
- Multi Classification Events will be awarded for 1st-3rd places calculated on British Disability Points in the final.
- Competitors will only receive a prize if they have achieved the qualifying standard (event qualifying time).

DOPING CONTROL

Swimmers are warned that random doping control may take place during this Meet.

ACCREDITATION

Swimmers must carry their Swim Wales or Home Country Membership card as accreditation. Access will not be given to the changing village or poolside without accreditation.

IMPORTANT – COACHES/CHAPERONE PASSES

All Coaches and Chaperones must have relevant accreditation. The new procedure for coach passes can be found at www.welshasa.co.uk calendar and competitions page.

PASSES WILL NOT BE ISSUED DURING THE MEET UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

SPECTATORS

Admission charges

- £4.00 per session Including free admission to finals session
- £7.00 per day
- £20.00 per weekend pass
- Reduced rates for children Under 16 / Senior Citizens

The seating at the WNP Swansea is arranged in rows that lead directly onto the pool deck. The first 5 rows are reserved for swimmers, coaches and team managers. Spectators will not be allowed into this area. Swimmers must make themselves available for marshalling as soon as advised by the public address system. Unless moving to marshalling, from swim down or following the completion of an event swimmers, coaches and team managers are requested to remain in their seats and not stand on the pool deck. A clockwise one way system will be in operation on the pool deck in order to keep the poolside area as free as possible.

The Spectator Area must be cleared at the end of each session.

CAR PARKING

A total of 250 car parking spaces including 21 disabled places and 3 coach bays are provided at the Wales National Pool. This is a pay and display car park and all charges are governed by WNP.

REFRESHMENTS

There is a cafe area serving refreshments for swimmers and spectators throughout the weekend. Refreshments may not be taken onto the poolside. There are also vending machines available for drinks.

SMOKING

Swim Wales has been asked by WNP Ltd to inform everyone using the facility that the complete complex, including the car park, is designated as a non-smoking area. Chewing gum is also banned.

CAMERA USE

The use of **all** photographic equipment is controlled at this meet and everyone is reminded that such equipment should not be used without a pass.

Passes can be obtained (free of charge) from the entry desk **upon proof of identity**. You will be issued with a tag for your photographic equipment and this must remain attached within the WNP area. Equipment being used without a pass will be removed. The records of camera use will be retained by Swim Wales.

MOBILE PHONES

Mobile phones must not be used in the pool hall and changing village.

SWIM SHOP

A Shop selling Swim Wales branded goods will be available during the meet.

06.02 Finals

In the finals, the maximum number of places practicable shall be allocated up to a total of eight competitors. When the programme of events includes semi-finals and finals the following shall apply: -

- 06.02.01** Semi-finalists shall be cyclically seeded from the results of the heats.
- 06.02.02** Finalists shall be allocated lanes using the spearhead principle from the results of the semi-finals.
- 06.02.04** The fastest heat of HDW events will be spearheaded

06.03 Withdrawals Procedure - Individuals

All withdrawals must be notified to the Meet office.

- 06.03.01** The Meet office must be informed of any withdrawals no later than 5.00pm on the day before competition.
- 06.03.02** Under exceptional circumstances only, withdrawals on the day of the Championship event may be accepted. However, these must be notified to the Meet Office on the relevant form.
- 06.03.03** Competitors failing to comply with the above shall be fined £10 for each inappropriate withdrawal.
- 06.03.04** Competitors wishing to withdraw from a semi-final or a final must inform the Meet Office (or Withdrawals Table if applicable) in writing on the relevant form immediately after the list of semi-finalists or finalists has been published or announced but within 15 minutes of the end of the session
- 06.03.05** Competitors who fail to appear for finals or the final heat of a Heat Declared Winner event will be fined and may be subject to further disciplinary action.
- 06.03.06** Any competitor withdrawing from a semi-final or a final preventing a reserve from taking part (except in the case of genuine illness or of a proven emergency) shall be fined as an inappropriate withdrawal and may be suspended immediately from all events at the Meet.
Where a reserve is brought in, the reserve shall occupy the vacant lane and there will be no amendments made to the allocation of other lanes.

06.04 Start Sheets

Start sheets will be prepared after the withdrawal deadline each day and will be available on the morning of the event.

06.05 Marshalling

It is the responsibility of the swimmer to report to the marshalling area in plenty of time before the event

06.06 Call Room

It is the responsibility of the swimmers **and reserves** to report to the first call room for costume checks 20 minutes before the start time of their final, they will then proceed to the second call room where they will remain until the marshal indicates they are to proceed to the poolside. Once a swimmer has entered the 1st call room, coaches shall have no access to their swimmers until the final has been completed.

Swimmers and reserves who do not comply with the above conditions will be treated as a withdrawal as in points 06.03.05/06 PLEASE NOTE IF SWIMMERS DO NOT REPORT TO THE CALL ROOM AT THE APPOINTED TIME, THEY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM IN THE FINAL.

06.07 Presentations

The Meet Director may decide to carry out presentations during the finals session. Competitors must report to the Presentation Marshall immediately after completion of their final. **Appropriate clothing, i.e. full tracksuit and training shoes must be worn for the presentation.** (Awards may not be presented if inappropriately dressed)

SW07 Other conditions

07.01 Starts

Over the top starts will, where necessary or appropriate, be used during Meets (except in the backstroke events).

07.02 Competitors' passes.

No competitors passes will be issued but all swimmers are asked to have their membership card with them. Checks on these will take place throughout the Meet.

07.03 Coaches/Chaperones

All Coaches and Chaperones must have relevant accreditation. Applications for coaches/chaperones passes must be made on the official form. All coaches chaperones and support staff must be a registered member of Scottish Swimming/Swim Wales/ or the ASA and be registered on their home country's Child Protection Database.

07.04 Presentations

Presentations will only take place if time permits.

SW08

Safety

All competitors are required to ensure that they observe all safety announcements and conduct themselves with safety in mind at all times.

SW09

TV, Video or Close Range Photography

When the competition involves young persons under the age of 18 years it shall be a requirement that staff shall be appointed at the entrance control to register details of any persons wishing to engage in any video, zoom or close range photography whether by camera, video or mobile phone.

Proof of identity will be required to register your photographic equipment for use at this event e.g. Driving License with photograph or Passport.

MULTI CLASSIFICATION ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

1. Entries from overseas competitors will be accepted providing that they have a classification that is listed on the IPC website (S1-S13) on the closing date of entries. No overseas entries will be accepted unless their classification can be ratified from the IPC website.
2. Entries from overseas competitors must be accompanied by a letter from their NPC/National Swimming Federation giving permission to compete at this event.
3. Entries from S1-S15 competitors will be accepted. Swimmers should indicate on the entry form their British Swimming / IPC / UKSAPLD / INAS-FID / UKDS classification.
4. This event will be held under IPC Technical Swimming Rules and Swim Wales promoters conditions.
5. All other rules listed in this meet pack must be adhered to.

Entry Times: Qualifying times are in place for this event.

Events: Heats will be seeded by entry times and not by classification. All events will be heat declared winner. There will be a Multi Classification final.

Withdrawals: All withdrawals must be notified to the meet office by 5.00pm on the day before competition. All withdrawals must be made by using the forms provided. Swimmers failing to comply with the above (except in the case of a genuine illness or proven emergency) will be liable to a £10 fine for each inappropriate withdrawal.

Medals: Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed swimmers male and female, calculated on British Disability Points in the final of each event. (Points are awarded to each swimmer in relation to how close they are to their classification world record in each event). Swimmers must swim faster than the event qualifying time for their classification in order to be eligible for a medal

Coaches/Chaperones/support staff accreditations: As per the general Meet conditions
Personal care attendants will only be permitted for swimmers in the following classes S1, S2, S3, S4 and S11. Such attendants will be excluded from any restrictions.
A swimmer in these classifications may have both a coach and a personal care attendant in attendance.

The additional Support Staff for S1, S2, S3, S4 and S11 will be allowed a coach pass free of charge. The Coach Pass application can be found on the www.welshasa.co.uk website.
